

Stylesheet Licence

Background

This Licence sets out general terms on which the Secretary of State for Business, Innovation and Skills, acting through Ordnance Survey (**we, us, our, Ordnance Survey**) licenses Stylesheets to persons who are licensed to use Licensed Data including you, the person seeking to use Stylesheets and who, by downloading and/or using such Stylesheets signals their agreement to be bound by this Licence and represents to us that they are licensed by us or one of our authorised licensees to use Licensed Data (**you, your**).

1 Definitions and interpretation

Expression Meaning

Data Agreement

means:

- a) any agreement pursuant to which you license Licensed Data from us or any of our authorised licensees; and/or
- b) any sub-licence entered into between you and your contractor pursuant to the terms of any agreement referred to in paragraph a) above,

in each case as amended from time to time.

Licence

means these terms and conditions (as amended from time to time).

Licensed Data

means any product licensed by us or any of our authorised licensees to you under a Data Agreement and for which we publish the Stylesheets on our website.

Intellectual Property Rights

means intellectual property rights, including copyright, patent, trade mark, design right, database rights, trade secrets, know how, rights of confidence and all other similar rights anywhere in the world whether or not registered and including applications for registration of any of them.

Stylesheet

means code that, when applied to geographic data, determines the visual appearance of the content (and any related files or code), published by us which is downloaded or used by you in any way.
